SHOW RULES

1. **Health papers are required.**
2. Any animal with any contagious diseases including, but not limited to, pink eye, sore mouth, ringworm, or abscesses in any stage will not be admitted. In the case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense. Animals refused for health reasons are required to stay in their vehicle and will not be shown. Please be considerate of the animals of other exhibitors by not bringing those goats that may be refused entry for health reasons.
3. **DOGS MUST BE CONTAINED. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
4. The American Boer Goat Association, The Missouri State Fairgrounds, Missouri Junior Boer Goat Association, or Advisors for the Missouri Junior Boer Goat, will not be held responsible for illness, injury, damage or loss of animals, person or property.
5. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE.**
6. YOU MAY SEND IN YOUR ENTRY FORM WITHOUT REGISTRATION NUMBERS IF YOU ARE WAITING ON REGISTRATION PAPERS...BUT *ALL OTHER INFORMATION MUST BE COMPLETED.*
7. ABGA SHOW RULES shall govern the open show.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP, OPEN COMMERCIAL DOES AND OPEN WETHERS

GENERAL RULES

1. Entries due day of show by 11:00 a.m.
2. Wethers must be weighed by 12:00 p.m. – no weigh back.
3. Ethical Fitting Practices must be observed at all times.
4. All wethers and commercial does must have a scrapie tag in place and match health certificate.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP

1. Age as of January 1.
2. Classes will be divided:
 - a. Pee Wee - 4 and under – no entry fee
 - b. Junior – 5 to 9 – Entry Fee \$5.00 at the gate – winner take all
 - c. Intermediate – 10 to 14 – Entry Fee \$5.00 at the gate – winner take all
 - d. Senior – 15 to 21 – Entry Fee \$5.00 at the gate – winner take all.

COMMERCIAL DOES

1. Entry fee \$15.00 per head.
2. Commercial Does may be exhibited with hair.
3. The commercial does will be shown in Divisions by age. Class breaks within the divisions will be calculated by weight.
4. Show management reserves the right to adjust the class numbers and breaks as needed.
5. Classes will be divided into three divisions
 - a. Class 1 will be for does that have all milk teeth in place
 - b. Class 2 will be for does with 2 adult teeth in place
 - c. Class 3 will be for does with 4 tooth and older
6. Grand and Reserve in each Division will compete for Grand and Reserve Overall.

WETHER SHOW

1. Entry fee \$15.00 per head.
2. Does are not eligible. Goats may be exhibit with hair.
3. Market goats will be shown in classes by weight. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the class numbers and breaks as needed.
4. Classes will be divided evenly into three divisions
 - a. Light
 - b. Medium
 - c. Heavy
5. Grand & Reserve in each Division will compete for Grand & Reserve Champion
