Conditions

1. The Employee must identify the candidate as a citizen in good standing: no arrests, maintained passing grades, and illicit free lifestyle.
2. Eligible expenses are limited to tuition, books/related supplies, parking or transit fees and student health insurance.
3. All awards will be paid directly to the educational institution. No payment will be made to the student for previously incurred educational expenses.
4. A scholarship award winner may reapply for subsequent scholarships provided they maintain a 2.0 GPA and all other scholarship requirements have been maintained.
5. Scholarships are granted based on availability of funds by the VIP Scholarship Committee.
6. Awards will be granted twice per year, at the end of May and the end of November.

1. Why do you deserve this scholarship?
2. What are your future career goals?
3. How has your education influenced your life?

Additional items to attach to your application:

1. The applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from school or a reputable personal reference (minister, mentor, etc.)
2. Proof of acceptance to the school or program.
3. Submit a letter from the probation employee who you have identified on page one identifying you as their dependent and why you deserve a VIP scholarship. If Self, submit letter of why you deserve a VIP scholarship.
