During a prosthetic evaluation, prosthetists have access to LCode Templates that cover the majority of the types of suspension, knees, and feet that we use so LCodes are not missed; and we have Code Intelligence Rules set up so we avoid any billing issues related to quantity or K-level restrictions.

How is CodeWise implemented in my practice?

The following steps outline the 8-12 hour process...

- **STEPONE** A Confidentiality Agreement, Business Associate Agreement, and Purchasing Agreement (with a Statement of Work) are executed.
- **STEP**TWO Apex 360 Systems hosts a GoToMeeting with client to go through the CodeWise Questionnaire. For example, do you fit preparatory prostheses? How many multiply socks do you typically dispense? Do you ever use cuff suspension (with a pelite liner and distal cushion) for patients with a transtibial amputation? Which 5 'vertical shock' feet would you like listed?
- **STEP**THREE LCode Templates are created and loaded into the practice management software remotely by Apex 360 Systems.
- **STEP**FOUR Apex 360 Systems provides training to client's prosthetists via GoToMeeting.

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
