

Courthouse Quilters Pincushion

Kit will contain wool for front and back of the pincushion and foundation fabric for stitching wool onto. Instructions for constructing the pincushion and for stitches are also included.

Supplies needed

- Threads for stitching wool together and for embroidery. I used Ellana wool thread and Eleganza perle cotton #8, however, embroidery floss, Valdani perle cotton, both #8 and #12, and DMC are all perfectly fine to use.
- Chenille needle #22 or #24. The size is determined by the thickness and type of thread.
- Straight pins
- White chalk marker. My favorite pen is the Fons & Porter mechanical pencil.
- Small sharp scissors
- 1" x 6" or 1" x 12" ruler is very helpful
- 1 ½ pound crushed walnut shells for stuffing



Jackie will have a selection of threads, needles, scissors, and markers with her to purchase on class day

Kits will vary in color combinations. One combination will be the same as the sample – yellow and green. One will be fall colors and a third will be bright sea blues and golds.
