

Anthony John Dubey, age 15, of Caseville, passed away Wednesday, Feb. 7, following a snowmobile accident Tuesday.

Anthony died about 11:30 a.m. at St. Mary's Hospital in Saginaw, where he was taken for treatment of head injuries.

His snowmobile collided with a pickup truck on Caseville Road. A passenger on his snowmobile, Leonard V. Schramski, 14, of Caseville, was taken to Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon and released Friday.

Anthony is the second fatality in Huron County for 1979, and is the second Caseville Public School Student to die this year. Todd Lapanowski, 6 was killed in a car-van collision on Jan. 19.

Anthony was born April 16, 1963 in Pigeon, and was a ninth grade student at Caseville High School.

Anthony is survived by his parents, John S. and Beverly Dubey, Caseville; two sisters, Deirdra and Rebecca, both at home; one brother, Ricky at home;

maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Anthony J. Scepanski, Caseville; paternal grandparents Mr. and Mrs. Robert J. Dubey, Sr., Bay Port, and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

A Funeral Mass was held Saturday, February 10 at 11 a.m. from St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville. The Rev. Fr. Joseph Schabel officiated, with burial in the church cemetery.

A scripture service was be held Friday, February 9 at 8 p.m. at the Shetler-Bussema Funeral Home.
