Lip Sync is a long standing tradition at VPE. Students grades TK-6 form a group, choose a song, and perform in a concert in front of the other students. The performances include lip sync technique, costumes, and props/backdrop. The performance will be professionally videotaped.

IMPORTANT DATES

Monday, May 1st - 1st day to turn in Student Contracts, Music and Lyrics. Practices can begin.

Friday, May 12th - Deadline to return Student Contracts, Music and Lyrics.

Wednesday, May 31st at 8:15am - Lip Sync Performance!

RULES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) Students participating in Lip Sync must turn in a signed "contract" by Friday, May 12th, to participate.
- 2) There must be at least two members in each group. No adults or teachers are allowed to participate in a student's group. Groups may include students from various grades.
- 3) Music selection and approval:
 - a) The duration of the songs must be three minutes or less.
 - b) Music must be appropriate for a school environment. Music will be reviewed and offensive songs may be rejected, even if edited.
 - c) Each song can only be used by one group. Priority will be given to the first group to turn in the required items (student contracts, group sign-up sheet, music and lyrics.)
 - d) Music and song lyrics must be emailed to vpelipsync@gmail.com by May 12th to ensure time to review.
- 4) On-campus practice rules. Failure to comply will result in loss of on-campus practice privileges:
 - a) On-campus practices are permitted from 2:25pm-3:45pm on the grass or blacktop, away from the buildings.
 - b) To practice on the stage you must get pre-approval from the lip sync coordinator, Kari Christie.
 - c) On-campus practices are not sanctioned or supervised by the school; parents must be present or make arrangements for their child to be supervised while on campus.
 - d) Siblings may not be on campus during practices.
 - e) All adults must sign in through the office before entering campus.
- 5) Performance Rules:
 - a) No gymnastics.
 - b) No throwing things into the audience.
 - c) If you choose to use a backdrop during the performance, it must stand independently or be taped to the windows. Nothing can be attached to the building walls.
- 6) Performances will start with the kindergarten and continue in grade order. Sixth graders will perform last, with the order chosen through a lottery system. No special accommodations or changes to the performance order will be made.

We look forward to all of the performances and know that it will be a fun experience for our kids!
