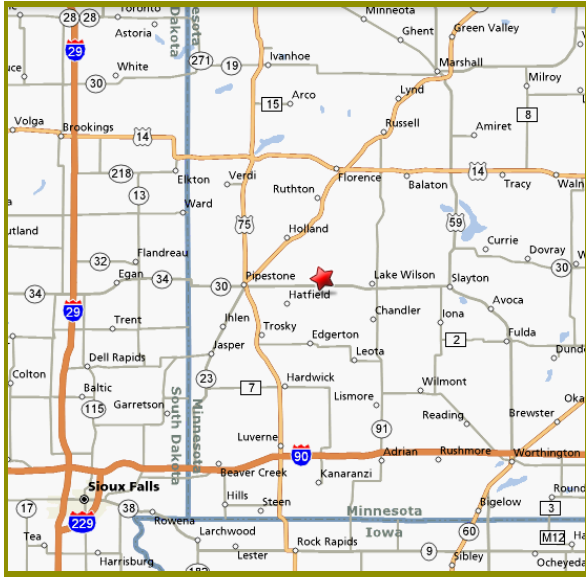

MISSION STATEMENT . . .

NewLife's Christian Track is an opportunity to learn sobriety and recovery in a Christian way, without the heavy pressures of the "worldly view" of change in society. Instead, individuals either Christian or non-Christian, who are seeking a higher, Christian pathway of change, can safely find refuge here at New Life Treatment Center. Pastors or families who send individuals to New Life Treatment Center can rest assured that their loved one will be treated with the Love of Christ.



TWO PROGRAMS OFFERED . . .

We offer two distinct, yet overlapping programs. Client's are able to choose the program they want and are not pressured one way or the other.

The Traditional 12-Step Program-is based on the 12 steps of AA, NA and GA. The emphasis is on the Alcoholic's Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous and Gambler's Anonymous programs and addiction therapy. Further explanation of this program is available at our website: www.newlifetreatment.com

The Christian 12-Step Program-is a Christ-centered, Biblical approach to recovery. It uses a Christian 12-step emphasis. More information on this treatment program is detailed in this brochure.

The Traditional 12-Step Program and the Christian 12-Step program are offered together in blended groups. Each client may choose which program best meets their needs. Each client may decide at any time to move to the other treatment program.

HONESTY, COMPASSION & REPENTANCE

HONESTY. . .

The first step to recovery from addiction is honesty.

Step One — We admitted we were powerless over our addictions and compulsive behavior — that our lives had become unmanageable.

This is the beginning of recovery for our clients. For those struggling with addiction, the Bible offers scripture to bring home this truth.

“What is impossible with men is possible with God.” Luke 18:27

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

While clients are going through the treatment process at our Christian drug and alcohol treatment center, they are encouraged to accept God and ask for His help to bring change into their lives.

COMPASSION . . .

We believe that compassion should be at the heart of our Biblically based ministry. We are committed to treat our clients with compassion, respect and reverence for each person's worth and dignity. The addict's problem is a spiritual sickness that only a “spiritual awakening” can address.

REPENTANCE . . .

The clients in our substance abuse and recovery program often exhibit signs of transformation and come to realize they have the opportunity to free themselves from their addictive behavior through a personal relationship with God. Clients must work their program daily to bring about change in

their lives. Clients who choose our Christian recovery program progress through treatment utilizing God and His wisdom to help make themselves whole again.

TREATMENT & RECOVERY. . .

Our Christian staff brings the best of psychological, medical, behavioral, pastoral and theological training and experience in order to address the suffering that comes from substance abuse.

Our Christian recovery track is Christ-centered. Clients start to open up their hearts and minds and “let God in”, and realize they can overcome their addiction with God's help. Clients begin to seek God's constant presence and are more capable of making wise decisions. Each client learns the importance of thanking God for all He is doing to help them through recovery and for continued strength to live life without addiction.

During their stay, residents may have pastoral visits at any time, day or evening, from their pastor. If an individual needs to have a pastoral visit, we have several local pastors who are available. Each client is required to do a 5th Step with a local pastor to, “admit to ourselves, God and another human being the exact nature of our wrongs”. Our goal is to guide the walking wounded in the healing process and restore them to a community of faith.

CHRISTIAN RECOVERY. . .

In addition to Alcoholic's Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous and Gambler's Anonymous, clients are referred to a Christian Recovery program or Christian 12 Step program after treatment in their locality.



Service Fees

New Life Treatment Center is a private non-profit organization operated by a Board of Directors. Donated funds from individuals, businesses, organizations and churches permit New Life Treatment Center to offer services for reasonable fees. Fees for services may be covered by private funds, insurance and public funds. A down payment is required for admission to programs by all self-pay clients. New Life Treatment Center is fully licensed for service by the Minnesota Department of Human Services and the Minnesota Department of Health.



PROGRAM OPTIONS . . .

Detoxification

- The client is provided with closely monitored care during the detoxification process with 24-hour nursing.
- Each detox client receives an interview for evaluation and assessment of chemical dependency.

Men's Inpatient

- We offer a 30 day individualized and tailor-made treatment plan set up for individual needs and goals.
- Quiet, rural setting with homelike surroundings.
- Separate from the women's program.

Women's Inpatient

- We offer a 30 day individualized and tailor-made treatment plan set up for individual needs and goals.
- Quiet, rural setting with homelike surroundings.
- Women are counseled on specific women's issues.
- Separate from the men's program.

Outpatient

- Eight week program—a total of 72 hours of service.

Meth Program

- Inpatient or outpatient.

Compulsive Gambling

- Inpatient or outpatient.

Aftercare

- Bi-weekly Growth Group—6 months required or longer if desired.
- Individual sessions, as needed.
