Army Chief Warrant Officer 3 (Ret) Donovan (Don) Alexander spent over 26 years in the military. CW3 Alexander started his career with the 2nd Bn, 75th Rangers at Ft Lewis, WA. Where he particiapted in numerous deployments and attended US Army Ranger school graduating as the Distinguished Honor Graduate of Class 10-79.
