

## **IMAGE OF HOPE RANCH COVID19 SAFETY PLAN**

Image of Hope Ranch wants to do everything possible to take measures and institute safeguards to ensure a safe environment for our visitors. This plan will be in effect until further notice.

To provide a safer environment, there will be no more than one session scheduled at a time. Clients are to wait outside of the barn until their session leader is ready for them. The grooming equipment and tools used for sessions will be disinfected after each session by the session leader.

Vulnerable Visitors and Volunteers – Those 65 and over and individuals with identified high-risk conditions are particularly vulnerable to coronavirus. Even with the safety measures we are taking, Image of Hope Ranch cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed to the coronavirus while at the ranch and you acknowledge this risk.

Image of Hope Ranch will have a no contact thermometer available to take the temperature of any visitors entering the barn. If a fever is detected we require you to cancel sessions for a 2-week period.

We ask that if you are showing any Covid19 symptoms or have been exposed to the coronavirus that you call and cancel your session for a 2-week period.

Personal Protective Equipment – Visitors and volunteers are not required to wear PPE (face mask or gloves) but may choose to do so.

Social Distancing will be practiced, but visitors acknowledge that during a session that may not always be possible. Client family/guardians and volunteer family members will remain outside of the barn but can view the session through the arena gate.

Clients and Volunteers will have access to hand sanitizer and must use this before and after sessions.
