### Ordinance No. 3

Regulating the exhibition of shows, and other public entertainments and exhibitions and restricting the business of auctioneers and peddlers within said village.

The village council of the village of New Munich do hereby ordain as follows:

Sec. I

No person, company or corporation shall, within the corporate limits of the village of New Munich exhibit or participate in, any caravan or menagerie, circus, theatrical performance, opera, concert, puppet show, wax figures, pictures, stationary, natural or artificial curiosity, feats of tumbling, sleight of hand performance, rope walking or dancing, boxing, wrestling or other feat of strength, marksmanship, or any other exhibition, show, display, or performance, for which any admission fee, compensation, reward, or other consideration whatsoever, shall be charged, demanded, solicited or received, nor hawk, peddle or sell by auction any goods, wares, merchandise or other commodity, without having first obtained from the recorder of said village a proper license therefor provided, however, that this ordinance shall not be construed to include, nor apply to, concerts or other exhibitions, or other performances or entertainments given by residents of said village, nor to religious, educational, scientific or literary lectures; nor to the hawking or peddling of farm produce, or products of his own industry nor to auction sales made pursuant to any law of this state or of the United States, by any officer or other person under and by virtue of any writ, execution, judgment, decree or order of any court.

Any person, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of section one of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be

punished by a fine not less than one nor more than one hundred Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, or be committed to the county jail of Stearns County or to the village jail of said village not to exceed ninety days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the village justice.

Sec. III

Before any license, provided for by section one of this ordinance, shall be granted, the person, company or corporation applying therefor, shall pay to the village treasurer the amount required by the village council therefor, and file with the recorder the treasurer's Receipt for said amount, which shall be at the rates hereinafter prescribed for each license, respectively, viz:

For a caravan, or menagerie, or circus for each exhibition for which a separate admission is charged, the sum of fifteen Dollars per day;

For each sideshow accompanying a caravan, menagerie or circus, the sum of two Dollars per day.

For each show or other exhibition in a tent and not hereinbefore provided for in this section the sum of Five Dollars per day.

For each theatrical troupe, minstrel's concert or opera troupe, the sum of two Dollars per day.

For each peddler with a team either one or two horses the sum of Five Dollars per day.

For each Peddler on foot or hand hawked peddler the sum of two and one half Dollars per day.

For each local auctioneer the sum of two Dollars per day.

For each transient Auctioneer not less than five nor more than fifty Dollars per day in the discretion of the village council.

For any other license required by section one of this ordinance, and not especially provided for in this section not less than one nor more than Five dollars per day, as the village Recorder shall in his discretion designate, upon application for such license.

Sec. IV

Any person, company, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of section three of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than one hundred Dollars, together with the costs of the prosecution, or be committed to the county jail of Stearns county, or the village jail of said village not to exceed ninety days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the village justice.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication.
