ITEMIZED BULK PICKUP LIST

City of Desloge Solid Waste Dept. can pick up household furnishings such as:

- Chairs, sofas, love seats
- Large household appliances such as: Small air conditioners, Freezers, Refrigerators (Doors and compressor removed)
- Dishwashers, clothes dryers & washing machines
- Ranges, stoves, microwave ovens
- Trash compactors
- Water heaters (drained of all water)
- Wood stoves
- Electronics (i.e., TV sets, stereos, computers, etc.)
- Large items that can be easily handled by two men (No single item to exceed 250lbs)
- Mattresses and box springs
- Carpeting (cut into 5' lengths, 24" circumference rolls)

For appliances, you must remove the doors and place it with the door facing down on the curb. All appliances with hinged doors, the door must be removed.

The maximum that can be picked up is approximately the amount that can fill the back of a pickup truck bed. Any pickup sites with more than the allowed amount, <u>the remainder will be left</u> <u>for resident disposal.</u>

Construction Material

Construction material or materials that result from home remodeling projects will not be picked up as part of normal trash or as bulk trash. This following list is not all-inclusive. Please contact Public Works Department to inquire if you have an item not listed. Some examples of the construction materials we are unable to pick up include:

- Bathroom fixtures (toilets, tubs, commodes)
- Kitchen fixtures (cabinets, islands, etc.)
- Flooring materials (tile, wood, vinyl, etc.)
- Drywall or sheet rock
- Large light fixtures (if the fixture does not fit in a 32 gallon can with the lid secured normally, we are unable to pick up)
- Plumbing (pipes, sinks, etc.)
- Roofing material (shingles, ceramic roof tiles, tar paper, gutters, fascia boards, etc.)
- Siding
- Wood (2x4s, plywood, paneling, peg board)

Items NOT ACCEPTED during Bulk pickup weeks

- Hazardous materials or chemicals (i.e. motor oils, liquid solvents, etc.)
- Latex Paints (still in liquid form)
- Oil based Paints
- Commercial items or business equipment
- Yard waste (i.e. leaves, grass clipping, garden vegetation, etc. must be placed in paper yard waste bags no plastic bags will be accepted.) Paper yard waste bags will be collected on Brush pickup week ONLY...4th week of every month
- Tree trunks or logs
- Building or construction type debris/materials
- Tires
- Auto batteries and motors
- Railroad ties
- Lumber, landscaping timbers
- Barrel drums
- Concrete, bricks, landscaping stones, boulders, rocks, dirt
- Household trash
- No large sections of glass. If you have large pieces glass it needs to be broken up, placed in a sturdy cardboard box, taped shut and labeled broken glass.
- Large quantities of animal manure, waste or liter

Request for pickup should be made no later than the last Friday prior to beginning of pickup week, by calling City hall or an online submission.

Accepted items must be placed out by 7 am on the first day of pickup week.

ONLY 1 pickup request per household during individual BULK weeks.

These services are not available to the following:

- Landlords cleaning up rental properties
- Multi-family units of 3 or more
- Commercial businesses
