RCIA/OCIA Scrutinies

Last weekend we celebrated the first of three Scrutinies. These ritual celebrations are for those who are making their final preparation for baptism. They are prayers

meant to uncover and heal all that is weak, sinful, and defective in the heart, then to strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.

At the Sunday Masses these rites are celebrated, the gospel readings are read from the Gospel of John; they are the stories of the Samaritan woman whom Jesus meets at Jacob's well, the healing of the man born blind and the raising of Lazarus from the dead. These readings focus on sin and redemption using the images of thirst and water, darkness and light, death, and life.

The Scrutinies remind us all of our need for continued healing, conversion, and reconciliation.
