ILLNESS REMINDERS

As we head into cold and flu season in addition to continued hypervigilance surrounding COVID-19, it is important to remember the following:

- Children must be fever free for 72 hours **WITHOUT** fever-reducing medicine before returning to school
- Our fever threshold has been lowered to 100.4
- Children cannot come to school if they have had any loose stools or vomiting in the last 24hrs. 3 consecutive loose BMs while at school will require pick up

NOVEMBER SERVICE PROJECT

Beginning Monday, November 9th through Friday, November 20th we will collect cans and nonperishable food items for the Northeast Georgia Foodbank for the upcoming holiday season. When the pandemic hit, there was a 40% increase in the level of demand for assistance from the food bank.
