On Friday, February 17, 2017 the <u>New York Times</u> reported that the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS), the federal agency that supports RSVP, the Foster Grandparent Program and the Senior Companion Program, known collectively as Senior Corps, and AmeriCorps has been included on a list of federal agencies to be eliminated in the FY 2018 federal budget. This elimination would be devastating to our community and to communities across our country.

Through these many years, we have mobilized thousands of older adult volunteers to improve the lives of tens of thousands of children, frail elderly and others in need, as well as supporting hundreds of area non-profits with desperately needed volunteer support. In just the last year alone, 1,482 older adult volunteers in these three programs provided 298,937 hours of service to our community and supported nearly 200 area non-profit organizations, including yours. Volunteerism has also clinically shown to improve the quality of life and increase life expectancy in our older adults!

We can stop these programs from being eliminated in the budget, but we must act now!
