Ash Wednesday Mass Schedule: 8:00 AM & 6:00 PM

Ash Wednesday is **February 17th**. The Vatican has given permission for the ashes to be received **ONLY** by a very light sprinkling upon the head (no physical touch of forehead or head) of ashes. Those who wish to be sprinkled with ashes should come forward like Communion. Father will sprinkle without saying anything. This custom is not a new practice as it is the norm in many parts of the world.

Lent Preparation:



Did you know it's just over one week until Ash Wednesday? Have you thought about how you will prepare to celebrate the season of Advent this year as an individual and as a family? Lent is about more than just fasting and includes the practice of prayer and

almsgiving as well. So what do these mean?

Fasting is a sacrifice that links our actions with the actions of Christ. This is a practice where we sacrifice something we enjoy, or 'die to ourselves' as an act of penance.

Prayer is the best way to strengthen our ongoing relationship with God. While we should always pray, Lent is a time to strengthen this practice even more. Each day try to gather as a family to pray for someone special.

Almsgiving is traditionally associated with putting money to the side to give to the Church that you would normally have used on yourself. Almsgiving should ultimately be a commitment to doing good deeds for others. You can give money to charity, or collect food for local food banks, or even practice doing good deeds for other members in your family! How is your family going to incorporate these three postures of penance into your routine during Lent?
