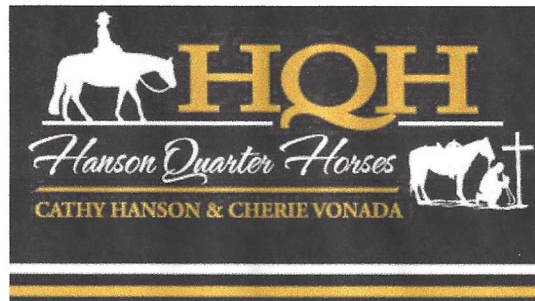


My Horse My Journey

Ranch Riding is a new event that is becoming very popular. It does not require an expensive horse, fancy clothes or tack. In a Ranch Riding class, competitors perform individually in a written pattern. The pattern consists of many different maneuvers which may include: pivots, extended gaits, side passing, riding over logs or lead changes. The ranch riding horse has a natural forward way of going, is responsive and compliant to his rider's requests, has a happy attitude and likes his job.

We will go over the different maneuver's, finishing up the clinic with each participant performing a Ranch Riding pattern.
