The co-worker had lived in New York as well as **ISRAEL**. The co-worker didn't really believe in God or the Bible, but was open enough to ask questions about the Bible as well as our beliefs!

While waiting on line to get into a local restaurant, I couldn't help but notice a familiar accent coming from the **PEOPLE** on line behind us. It turned out they were a group of Israelis, from Las Vegas, working in Atlanta for the weekend. I made sure to tell them about their Messiah!

While waiting for a red light, I noticed the young **MAN** in the car next to us taking pictures of our ministry van!

We had ministry tables at the Fall Russian Festival at a church outside of Atlanta. We supplied people with hundreds of evangelistic items. One **WOMAN** showed me the Star of David with a cross in it pendant she had bought from us last time. She said many people complimented her on it, and she wanted to say thank you!

I wore a "*Jesus Loves You*" Jewish star t-shirt and walked around the Johns Creek Arts Festival. Many Jewish **PEOPLE** have moved to this area of Atlanta. Many people were challenged by my t-shirt. I saw **DAVIDA** and **APRIL**, two Jewish believers I know as well as interact with **OTHERS**.

Southern Women's Show Jacksonville, Florida

We set up a booth at the Southern Women's Show in Jacksonville, Florida. Our ministry banner hung in the middle of the back wall with an Israeli flag attached to it. Many Jewish and other **PEOPLE** were challenged by our presence, several asked questions and some took Gospel tracts. Although it is somewhat costly, we sold our "*Jesus Loves You*" Jewish star t-shirts and other evangelistic items for \$1 equipping hundreds with evangelistic tools!
