The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:30 p.m., in the City Hall. Jim Poepping, Shawn Duevel, Pat Nathe, Elmer Boecker and Ron Doll were present.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Shawn Duevel and carried the minutes from April 1st, 2019 were approved.

Fire Chief, Allen Fiedler was present to inform the Council of five medical call last month. Burning restricted are still on for Stearns County as of today. Al talked to Matt at Worms regarding an addition to the Fire Hall, looking for ideas to keep the cost down. Al will also meet with Tom Hoppe regarding the electrical service. Allen submitted two bills that needed to be paid Albany Floral (paid to Kurt Ritter) \$83.01 & Stearns County Chiefs meal \$30.

Waste/Water Operator, Tom Valerius was present to inform the pump house breaker tripped again, the main is weak. City clerk and Tom will talk to Tom Hoppe to get a quote to have this repaired. Tom mentioned he will talk with H & H Contracting Inc to schedule our water tower inspection and cleaning for 2019. The water is turned on at the cemetery and ball park. Tom also mentioned the oxygen levels on the ponds are low. He is asking the Council to pump water from the south pond to the north pond to balance it out or add air into the pond. He received a quote from R-Way pumping for \$800 to raise the water around 6", which will take about 3-4 hours, on a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Pat Nathe and carried the approval of the quote from R-Way Pumping. Tom will also talk to Mike Nielson regarding the annual cleaning of the lift stations. Tom did some sampling and well #3 nitrates were a little high, with the seasons changing this is normal, the state has been notified and we were told it will take time to balance out.

City Clerk, Stacy Funk informed the council and public regarding Grass and Leaf pick up is scheduled for Saturday, May 11th. Place at the end of your driveway and keep bags open.

On a motion by Pat Nathe, seconded by Ron Doll and carried a one-day on sale liquor license was approved for the New Munich Jaycees for Munichfest Resolution 5-19-A.
