Watson B. Robinson, 68, of Harbor Beach passed away Thursday, June 29, 2000, in St. Mary's Medical Center in Saginaw following a brief illness. Watson was born on June 7, 1932, in Harbor Beach to the late Vernon and Beatrice (Chickenoski) Robinson. He and Phyllis Terrill were married on May 23, 1996, in Harbor Beach.
