



YEAH Youth Animal Project Guidelines 2017

- Awesome...You want to raise an animal for YEAH!
- The first step is to contact a member of the YEAH Adult Council to get your information packet (contact info at the bottom of the page)
- Please read through all the materials provided
- Complete the Youth Animal Project Contract, photo release, and make sure you have all required signatures
- Complete your Budget (estimated)
- Make copies of your contract and budget for your records. After your project is over you will need to complete your budget and feed expense sheet and turn them in with all receipts to the YEAH Adult Council
- The YEAH Adult Council will review and approve your contract and budget
- **No** animals should be purchased or obtained before a contract and budget has been submitted and approved by the YEAH Adult Council
- Reimbursement amount of animals not purchased or provided by YEAH will be determined by auction market value at the time of purchase
- If YEAH animal(s) are being raised with market animals for the JLA Auction any YEAH provided feed will be only for the YEAH animals
- Any donations received will be promptly submitted to The YEAH Adult Council with a completed donation form
- Updates on how your animals are doing every month are expected and appreciated by attending a YEAH Youth Council meeting or by email to your species representative.
- YEAH animals will not be shown as market animals during the Clark County Fair either in 4-H or FFA.
- If you have any questions please contact your species representative.

Youth Participant will notify the YEAH Council immediately if the animal requires veterinary care beyond normal needs to determine what action is to be taken. Amazia Veterinary Service is the designated veterinary clinic by the YEAH Council. Emergency phone for Amazia is 360-892-7524.

Youth Participant is encouraged to be a member of and attend at least one meeting of the YEAH Youth Council to present their project.

Youth Participant agree to notify the YEAH Council on the progress of and any YEAH promotion of the animal at the YEAH Youth Council meetings or by note/email every thirty (30) days. Pictures are encouraged.

The YEAH Council agrees to provide a letter of support for the youth project and will direct funds received according to the mission statement, which supports the Clark County Food Bank.
