
NO IN-ROOM PARTY POLICY

IAINE is One of America's largest blueberry growing states, raising 90% of the low-bush blueberries in North America

MAINE is about 320 miles long and 219 miles wide, and has a total area of approximately 33,215 square miles

MAINE has 436,064 acres of state and national parks, including the 92 mile Allagash Wilderness Waterway in Northern Maine

MAINE is almost as big as all the other five New England States combined

MAINE has one county (Aroostook) so big (6,453 square miles) that it actually covers an area greater than the combined size of Conneticut and Rhode Island

MAINE has 2,295 square miles of inland water and over 2,000 coastal islands

MAINE potatoes rank third in acreage and fourth in production nationally

MAINE'S highest point in apporximately one mile high, it is Mt. Katahdin at 5,268 feet above sea level


