

Grade 3 Music Curriculum Framework Document

Music for Year 3

Exploring descriptive sounds – Animal Magic

- 1. Developing children's ability to create descriptive sounds on the theme of animals.
- 2. Compose and perform a short piece combining sounds, movement and words, question and response in musical form.
- 3. Use stories to create sound pictures and sound effects.

Exploring rhythmic patterns

- 1. Exploring rhythms and chants using repeated phrases.
- 2. Creating simple patterns and performing in a group/individually.
- 3. Using musical notation as a means of communicating.
- 4. Using music from other times, cultures, and countries.

Exploring arrangements

- 1. Developing rhythmic patterns to accompany a song.
- 2. Developing musical accompaniments, e.g. chords.
- 3. Play and sing using rhythms and instruments together.
- 4. Accents on musical contrast loud/soft/high/low, etc.
- 5. Play a variety of melodies on tuned percussion instruments.
