Further, I and any other person or entity with a legal claim on said animal will further exempt Kenosha Running Company; and its sponsors for any and all claims of damages and liability from injury, property damage, loss, claim or expense resulting from the behavior of my animal; and to report any and all such injuries or incidents to XThrilllogy, CaniCross USA, and/or the Kenosha Running Company.

1. Dogs need to be in good health. Initial
2. Aggressive dogs towards other dogs or a person will be asked to step away, if it happens again any point, even during the run/walk, the dog will need to leave the event. Initial
3. Dogs that attempt to bite another dog or person, need to immediately leave the public area and return to the car. The dog will not be allowed to run in the event or return to the public area. Initial
4. CaniCross USA is not responsible for the action of a dog at an event, specifically dog bites and attacks. Initial
5. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dog in a proper way. Initial
6. Dogs are not permitted in any enclosed buildings or enclosed shelters. Initial
