



2016 Senior Scholarship Application - Due Date: March 11, 2016 (postmarked)

Criteria for \$1000 Scholarship:

- Applicant must be a high school graduate before August 2016.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance into a post-secondary institution.
- Applicant must provide evidence of financial need.
- Applicant must evidence interest and participation in showing dogs by any of the following:
 - Competing in at least 5 Junior Showmanship competitions within the last 2 years.
 - Competing in at least 5 AKC dog shows within the past 2 years showing in breed or performance.
 - Competing in a combination of up to 5 related competitions from the any of the following groups: NADAC, 4H, UKC, ASCA, IABCA, or any other accredited organization
- Applicant must document participation in a manner which can be confirmed with official records from the related agency
- Applicant should include information on additional dog related activities such as a regional club, therapy, rescue, education, etc. This information will be used in deliberation process but is not a requirement to qualify for the award.
- Applicant must apply on an official CKC application form.
- This scholarship will only be awarded once to an individual once proof of enrollment has been received.
- All personal application information will remain confidential.

Please include the following items with the application:

1. Complete Resume including extracurricular activities, leadership positions held, work experiences, and any activities related to canines. The resume should list competitions, titles, and any other pertinent information.
2. A brief (100 words) statement of your current need for financial assistance.
3. An essay (2 pages or less) describing why you became involved with dogs and what your plans are for the future.
4. 2 letters of reference from a school administrator, teacher, counselor, or community member containing evidence of your dedication to dogs and your ability to be successful in post-secondary education. Letters of reference must include contact information.
5. SAT or ACT test scores, these can be copies of the score report or can be on letterhead signed by a school official.
6. Transcript (can be unofficial) including the student's SS#, birthdate, GPA (both unweighted and weighted), rank, and semester averages.
7. Finalists may be called for an interview with the scholarship committee.
