## **TECHNOLOGY**

Our St. Anthony Jr. High program is highly integrated with technology. In most cases, students do not have hard copy textbooks for their classes. Instead, we use online “Techbooks”, .pdf books, and a variety of online resources to teach core subjects. Thanks to our Parent Involvement Program (P.I.P.), we will have a 1:1 ratio of students to Chromebooks. Each student will be assigned a Chromebook and will be responsible for that Chromebook for the entire school year. Chromebooks will remain in the Jr. high building and cannot be taken home. We will continue to refine our use of the Google Apps for Schools environment where students will be able to email, work, and save/share documents in a Cloud system. We are very excited about the technology format we have here at St. Anthony’s for our Junior High students and we look forward to a fun-filled and rewarding year.

## **LOCKERS**

6<sup>TH</sup> – 8<sup>TH</sup> Grade students will continue to have lockers this year. Each student will be assigned a locker at Back-to-School night. 8<sup>th</sup> grade students have the first pick of lockers. Then, there will be a name raffle for 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students to pick their lockers with 7<sup>th</sup> graders going first. It is highly recommended that students bring a combination lock for their locker. Students may decorate their locker, but **no stickers are allowed**. Magnets are fine. Students will have 5 minutes between classes to get the necessary items from their lockers.

## **UNIFORMS**

**We are currently updating the handbook and it will be available at the end of July.** There will be updates to the dress code so make sure that you check for updates. Additional requirements for junior high students are as follows:

**7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys need to wear a button down white shirt with a tie on any day we have Mass (*usually Fridays*). They will need to purchase a school tie from Dennis Uniform** to wear on these days. Boys will need to make sure that all of their buttons are buttoned and that their shirts look presentable. Ties need to be worn correctly. Shirts should be tucked in and boys should be wearing a belt.

**7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls need to wear a skirt on any day we have Mass (*usually Fridays*).** Skirts should meet the guidelines set forth in our Parent/Student Handbook (*update posted on the website at the end of July*). If a girl decides to wear an undershirt, no more than one inch of that undershirt may be visible from under their uniform shirt.
