

Pease, Robert F. "Bob"

Robert F. "Bob" Pease, 72, of Fort Gratiot passed away on Sunday, Dec. 9, 2007 following an extended illness.

He was born on July 7, 1935 in Harbor Beach, son of the late William Wallace and Mae (VanVoorhees) Pease.

After graduating from Port Hope High School, bob spent 44 years with the Port Huron Times Herald, retiring on Jan. 1, 1989. He began his career delivering the Times Herald as a boy before becoming systems manager at the paper. He was a presiding elder at the Fort Gratiot Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints and the Port Huron Restoration Branch.
