

11. Lu Cortis - Cabin By The Lake by Royal Quilt Designs pattern

-Dark Blue for outside borders and binding: 3 1/3 yds

-Light Blues: #1- 1 1/4 yard

#2- 1 yard

#3- 1/2 yard

-Medium Blues: #- 1 1/4 yard

#2- 1 1/4 yard

#3 -1 yard

-Purples for mountain: Light value- 1/4 yard

TWO Mediums- 1/4 yard each

Dark- 1/3 yard

-Teal Blue for water: Light value- 1/3 yard

Medium- 1/4 yard

Dark- 1/3 yard

-Greens: THREE different values- 1/2 yard each

-This supply list assumes that you will be pulling some additional fabrics from your stash and just lists the fabrics you will be needing more of. If you will not be pulling from your stash, a bunch of fat quarters works. You'll need the fall colors for leaves, colors for the sun, assorted greens for trees, and the cabin fabrics. You will figure it out as you are doing all of the cutting prep at home. ☺

-Neutral thread for piecing

-Sewing machine in good working order with new needle.

-Quilter's square, 4 1/2" is nice but larger will always work just as well

-Quilter's ruler, 6 x 12 ish is handy

Precut as instructed by patterns. We will basically be making one each of the different blocks. **DON'T CUT THE MOUNTAINS AND WATER BLOCKS. WE WILL BE USING TRIANGLE PAPER WHICH I WILL SUPPLY.** So, for the mountains 3" squares, instead cut a 13" x 10" of the medium and the dark and a 10 1/2" x 10" of the medium light and the dark. You will still cut the other pieces for these blocks, just not the half squares triangle pieces.. if this is clear as mud, email me.

ALSO DON'T CUT THE THREE INCH SQUARES FOR THE WATER CLOCKS. INSTEAD BRING 2 FAT QUARTERS OF MEDIUM, 1 FAT QUARTER OF LIGHT

AND 1 FAT QUARTER OF DARK. Still cut the other pieces you need for the blocks, other than 1/2 square triangles.

It's going to be an action packed day so the more organized you are with your cutting and marking, the better it will go for you. Clip together, or put in baggies each block to keep all the pieces together. See you soon!
