### **B-25J "Executive Sweet" to fly in Memorial Day Freedom Flight**

You hear them before you see them. A solid

thrumming of airplane engines will announce their arrival just before they top the trees at 11:04 am on Memorial Day at Templeton Cemetery. As they move into the "Missing Man" formation, the planes pass over the American and military services flags standing at attention near the center of the cemetery - then fly off to their next destination.

Two planes will participate in Monday's Freedom Flight. Eagle 1 is a B-25J with lead pilot John Garlinger and navigator George Marrett. Eagle 2 is a T-28 piloted by Randy Wilber with Jeff Quaid and is the right wing and missing man.

The planes will take off at 10:50 am and pass over several designated areas at specific, exact times - Paso Robles Cemetery (11:00), Templeton Cemetery (11:04), Santa Margarita Cemetery (11:14), San Luis Obispo Cemetery (11:25), and Los Osos Memorial Park (11:30). Once the mission is completed, the planes will fly back to the Paso Robles Airport.

**[From Caltrans]** The urgent clean up and repair of a substantial rock and dirt slide on State Route 2 (Angeles Crest Hwy) in the San Gabriel Mountains in Angeles National Forest this winter required a unique piece of equipment that climbs and clears slopes too steep for regular bulldozers.


The proposal would implement a safe drinking water fund as outlined under SB 200, authored by Senator Bill Monning (D-Carmel). Rather than rely on new revenues, the Senate's proposal authorizes the continuous appropriation of \$150M annually from the General Fund.
