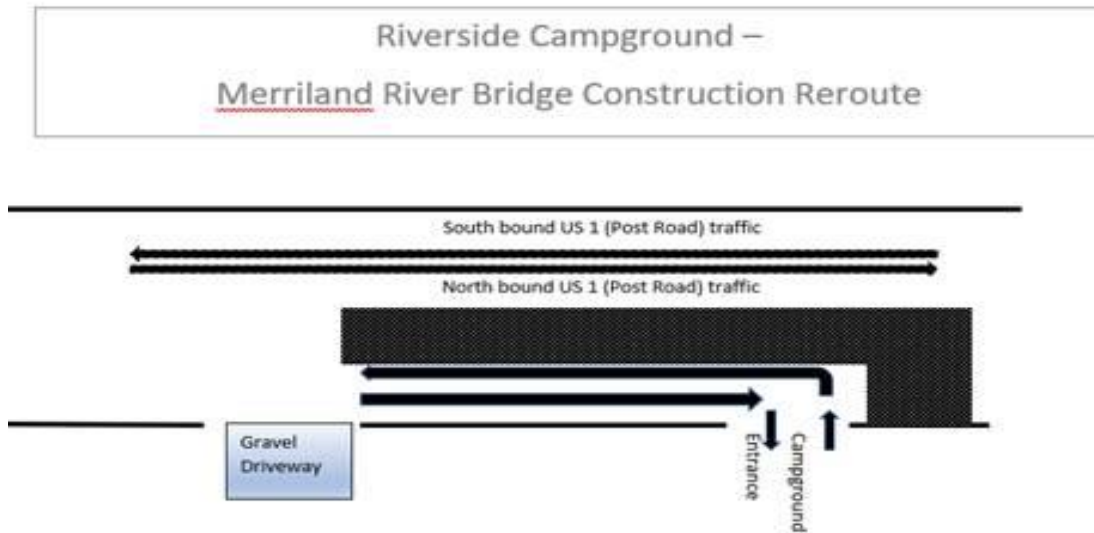


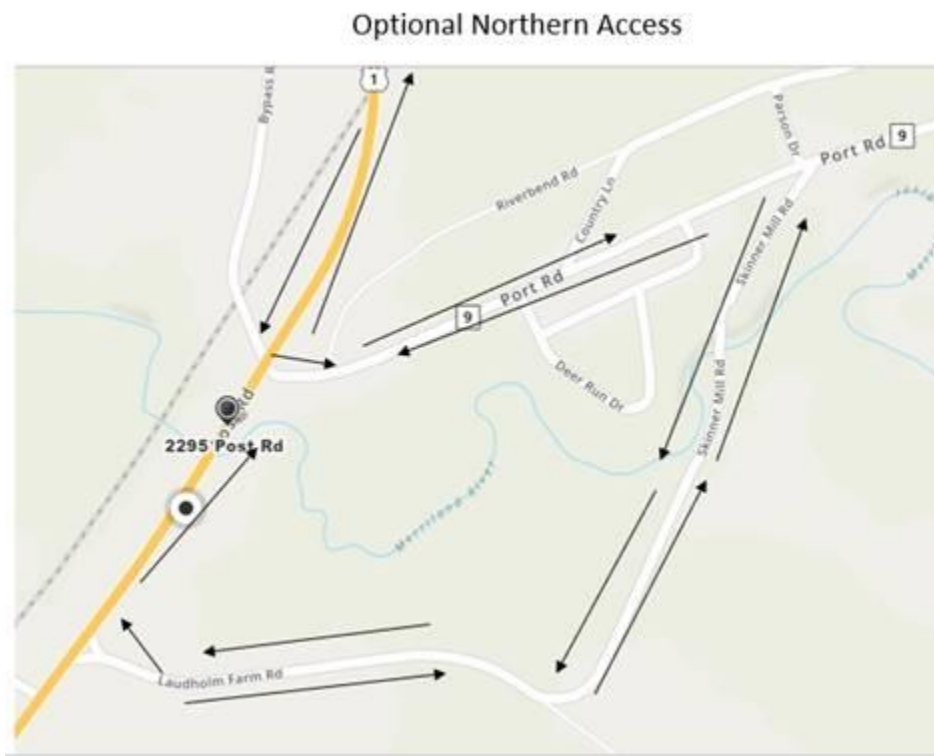
On Tuesday, April 30, 2019, Kevin and I met with the project engineer, superintendent of the bridge construction, and a supervisor. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the traffic control measures that are necessary to complete construction. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of June.

Effective Friday, May 3, 2019, the bridge will reopen to 2-way traffic on the west side of US 1. The east side (the campground side) will be closed at the bridge requiring traffic entering the campground to approach from the south and use a dedicated right turn lane (for campground use only) to enter.

Traffic departing from the campground will only be allowed to turn southbound on US 1. There will be barriers set up to isolate the workers from the 2 way traffic so that they can complete construction on the east side of the bridge.



If you approach from the north, you will be required to go past the campground and turn around. Another option is to turn at Route 9 (Port Road), take a right onto Skinner Mill Road, and proceed to Laudholm Farm Road. Take a right. When you reach Route 1 (Post Road) take another right. The campground will be just past the Maine Diner on the right. This detour is about 2.8 miles.



Most importantly, as the workmen stated, there could be changes to this plan. If there are, we will keep you updated!!! There will be a number of signs posted with directions.
