The Pentwater Sportfishing Association held “Bannink’s Lines Down” fishing tournament Saturday, August 17th. Twenty boats participated and over 800 pounds of fish were caught! Prizes were awarded and the crew of “Lym Time” (with captain Steve Weber) secured the largest King Salmon weighing in at 22.50 pounds. The heaviest trout was a Steelhead weighing 12.60 pounds brought in by “Fish Eagle” (captained by Steve Sauser). The heaviest combination weight (of salmon and trout) was awarded to “Fish N Overtime” (with captain Robert Halfacre) with their top three fish weighing 46.05 pounds. The mystery weight category (set at 4.20 pounds) was won by “Little Windy” (captain Win Matteson) with a King Salmon weighing 4.25 pounds. Cash prizes were awarded, and all participants received the annual consolation prize towels. A mini tournament will be held on Saturday, August 31st, which will conclude the 2024 fishing season.
