Pastoral Thoughts

Soon we will start a very important period in our spiritual life. Sunday, February 23, 2020 is "Boon Barekendan." Lent period starts with "Barekendan". Immediately after "Barekendan" the next day we start lent. During this period we do proper church services with proper psalms, prayers, hymns etc. All these services are inviting us to confession and prepare us for the Triumphant Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. That's why our Lord came to the earth. That's why He was incarnated and helped us to see the real life and to seek it. Beautiful church services lead us during this whole period bringing us proper spiritual feelings and thoughts.

Great Lent is a wonderful time for us as Christians to revise our faithfulness toward our Lord, toward our church and finally toward God's commandments. Rituals and ordinances in the church really help us to exercise real lent. Prayers, litanies, hymns and in general the design of our services have provided for believers a divine environment. In this sense it is very important to be in the church especially in this period. Of course church is always important for our spiritual life but the lent is a period when we approach the very important celebration which is Resurrection. All church services are concentrated on our own self-criticism. Self-criticism is the best confession. We need to revise our life that we lived before and we need to try to correct all our wrong and bad actions. That's what I want to be transferred to you dear faithful. Without sincere confession there is no mercy for our sins. Our God is merciful, but even this wouldn't help us if we don't confess and expiate our sins. There is a wonderful tradition in our St. Mary Church which we will continue to do this year and I would like you to come and join us and to be a part of this service.

Every Wednesday within Great Lent we have evening service; you can check the attached calendar. The good thing during these services is all attending believers are participating by reading their parts of "I Confessing with Faith" which is written by St. Nerses the Graceful. These readings are joint prayers which gives us an opportunity to bring together our thoughts and to pray for each other also.

I will pray for all of you and may God help us to have sincere confession according to the words of the hymn: "Before Your precious and all-victorious cross we bend our knees, we worship You and we ask forgiveness of our sins"

We then went over the administrative report to the 55 delegates in attendance. There were presentations by Silvana Vartanian (Nerouj Chairman), Mihran Toumajan (Western Regional Director, Armenian Assembly of America's), Nichole Nigosian (Chairman of Armenian Church Summer Camp), Stepan Khzrtian (Diocesan Council), and the Honorable Judge Adrienne Krikorian (Diocesan Council Chairwoman and President of Mer Hooys).

Friday night we had Fiesta Night Social, Saturday was the banquet, and Sunday we celebrated Divine Liturgy where four ACYO members were ordained to the order of Acolyte. The New ACYO Central Council was prayed for and blessed by His Eminence Archbishop Hovnan Derderian.

Feast of St. Ghevond the Priest and His Companions

The Feast of St. Ghevond the Priest and His Companions is dedicated to the blessed memory of the Armenian priests who fought alongside St. Vartan and the entire Armenian Nation for their Christian faith in 451 A.D. in the Battle of Avarayr.

The eldest among them was Priest St. Ghevond, and among his companions were Catholics Hovsep, Bishop Sahak of Syunik, Bishop Tatik of Basen, Priest Mushe or Mushegh, Priest Arshen, Priest Samuel, Deacons Abraham and Kajajn. After the Battle of Avarayr the Persian King Hazkert took revenge on Armenians and ordered to kill the brave priests. According to the tradition the day of the Feast of St. Ghevond the Priest and His Companions is the day of the clergy.



Feast of St. Vartan the Captain and Companions

The Feast of St. Vartan the Captain and his 1036 Companions marks their martyrdom 1551 years ago in the battle of Avarayr, fighting for the freedom of conscience and religion for the Armenian Nation. It was to be the first testimony of many to follow that the Armenians were a people who freely chose Christ, remained steadfast in their Christian faith, and would not betray that faith for any ransom. "Vartanants" as it is commonly called, is one of the most sacred feasts of the Armenian people.

In the Armenian Church, the Feast day of St. Vartan the Captain and Companions is also celebrated as the Naming Day of His Holiness Karekin II. To mark the occasion, at the conclusion of Divine Liturgy, a Pontifical Prayer is offered before the Holy Altar of Descent.
