

During Lent

The Wednesday worship services during Lent offer us the opportunity to explore Luther's Catechism.

Some people are among us who never had the opportunity to formally study Luther's Catechism (which outlines basic Lutheran Teaching). This series of midweek Lenten sermons will provide the opportunity for that instruction. Since not all of us are able to attend these services, the confirmation sermon series will be videoed and distributed so all may participate at their convenience.

The 40 days of Lent have been used for centuries as a time for catechetical instruction. Our use of this time for catechetical instruction draws on that very long tradition.

Minutes from the Annual Meeting

January 26th, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President Rose Anne Hoekstra at 10:50 am. Gayle Harrop served as Secretary. Tom Morris and Greg Kriewalt served as tellers. A quorum was present.

Accept the agenda: Judy Perryman moved to accept the agenda, second by Jean Whiteley. Motion carried.

Approval of minutes from previous meeting: Nancy Knapp moved to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2019 meeting, second by Cindy Johnson. Motion Carried.

Approval of reports: All reports were not read since they all appear in the 2019 annual report. Brief summaries and highlights were provided by Cindy Johnson (Outreach & Care), Brian Adams (Support), Gayle Harrop (Youth & Family).

2019 Financial report: Presented by Brock Bentson, referencing the balance sheet and profit and loss reports on pages 20-22 of the Annual Report. Motion to accept the financial report made by Judy Perryman and seconded by Nancy Knapp. Motion carried.

2029 Budget presentation: Brock Bentson explained the 2020 proposed budget as shown on the Proposal Handout. A motion was made by Bill Rayner to accept, seconded by Jean Whiteley.

New Motion was made by Bill Rayner to allow borrowing from the building fund if the need arises as a safety net. No objections. Motion carried.

Elections: There are 4 positions available for 3 year terms. The nominating committee presents 3 candidates for those positions, Carolyn Gratz, Bill Rayner, and Elaine Tredinnick. Asked for nominations from the floor for a 4th candidate. No nominations were made. There is also one position available with a one-year term. Asked for nominations from the floor for this position and no nominations were made.

Brock Bentson moves to suspend a vote on the candidates and accept them all unanimously. No objections, motion carried.

On Sunday, February 2nd, all available council members will be installed at the 9:30 service.

Amendment to the Constitution: As shown on page 23 of the annual report, there is a proposed amendment to the Constitution to allow the notices to members of the Annual Meeting to be sent/communicated by means other than "by mail". Changing the wording to "by any means available" will allow Trinity to explore other options such as email for future annual meetings. Motion proposed by Jeffrey Koth and seconded by Ed Kramer.

Amendment to the Constitution: A yellow flyer was handed out with a proposed amendment to Section C10.04 of the constitution of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church. This amendment defines how a quorum is established for congregational meetings. Discussion led by Pastor Jeff Koth. Motion to accept made by Bill Rayner, second by Nancy Knapp. Motion carried.

Adjournment: Joe Doninger moved to adjourn, seconded by Danielle Navarro.

Project(s) Status:

Main Building/Grounds Maintenance:

TV Monitor was procured and hung in the sanctuary. Electrical work for permanent installation still needs to be completed.

Altar Guild door to altar suffered prior damage due to earlier water leaks. Trim was glued/nailed to repair.

Communion rails had pinch points at the corners ... corners fastened to remove pinch points.

Church pew broke loose from the floor anchors, pew re-anchored.

Nursery toilet was leaking, replaced wax ring on toilet. Sign needed to remind users to not flush diapers, wipes, feminine products or paper towels.

Nursery sink plugged – plug removed, sink flowing clear.

Repaired loose/broken choir loft handrail

Kitchen

Kitchen went through a health department inspection Feb 14th with the intent of learning our current limitations and developing a plan for expansion of use.

Tech Corner:

A TeraStation 1 TB fault tolerant RAID file server was installed on our church network. It is located next to the AT&T Uverse Gateway in the submarine room on the lower level. There are three things that need to be done to allow our windows 10 systems to communicate with the server.

- 1. Nancy's computer in the church office was set up to use the server drive from Share Drive Z. Al also updated her windows software, Microsoft Edge to a new edition, and checked her disk drives for file system errors.

First Communion


All children ages 10 (in the calendar year 2020) and older are eligible for 1st communion instruction and participation. There will be an orientation for the parents of first communicants on:
