Once Upon A Time, on August 27th, 1919 Nittany Post 245 received their post 245 charter from national.

Then on October 19th, 1919, Post 245 was formally organized when some 20 veterans met in the Nittany Inn Parlors, now The Hotel State College.

After changing meeting sites several times, the little shack in the woods was established on October 1st, 1963 as the new post home. Then on October 21st, 1990 our current post home was constructed and opened for business.

We are excited to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of our recognized charter on August 10th, 2019
