## TIMELY TIPS FOR THE GARDENER

Before the first frost pick any green tomatoes and ripen them inside in a cool location.

After first hard frost lift tender bulbs and store for next spring planting.

Cover ponds with a net to prevent falling leaves from getting into the water.

Plant spring bulbs for a beautiful Spring display.

Rake leaves off the lawn and start a compost pile.

Rake and discard fallen rose leaves to prevent disease from wintering over.
