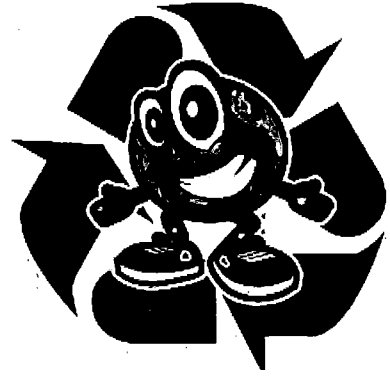

The Wyandot County Solid Waste Management District is accepting applications for a Community Recycling Grant. These grants are offered to townships, municipalities, local government offices, schools and nonprofit organizations to initiate or expand recycling, to purchase recycling or waste containers, to purchase items made from recycled content materials, to perform cleanup activities, or to conduct an approved demonstration project. Grants will have a maximum award amount of \$2,500 per application. All organizations will be limited to one application per year. The District will make approved purchases for the grant award recipient. Grant applications will be accepted until February 1, 2019. An evaluation committee will be used to score applications. A minimum score of 70 out of 100 possible points must be achieved to be considered for grant funding. Successful grant applications will be selected and notified by March 29, 2019. All applicants selected to receive grant funding from the Wyandot County Solid Waste Management District will sign an agreement form before commencement of project. A grant closeout report will be required by all applicants who receive grant funding at the end of the grant project.
