

Car Show Updates & News

Carter Hill Christian Church Show: We have set the date for our second trip to Bethlehem. The show will be on Saturday, August 19th, one week later than last year so we will not compete with the Tucker Main Street Cruise-in.

How to Improve Your Chances of Winning At a Popular Choice Show

At almost every show, someone comments about some of the same participants that almost always win an award. We've noticed that, too, so we decided to do an "investigation" into this.

Well, a lot of the answers are pretty obvious. Those that win most often are usually some of the first ones at the show and get the primo spots

(usually near the registration canopy) and stay close to their cars. They talk to the spectators about their cars and tell them they can vote for their favorites and where to get a ballot. One car owner is well known to let kids (of all ages) sit in his red T-bucket. This will definitely translate into votes! Sometimes to be in the Top 20 it only take 4-5 votes, so that can be the difference between winning and going home empty handed.

If you come late, many have already made their choices and deposited their ballot in the ballot box. Occasionally a "stunning" car will come in late and get a ton of attention, but this is an exception to the norm.

When our staff is counting the votes, they don't know whose car is what number. What they DO know is when someone tries to "Stuff the Ballot Box" to skew the results to help their car win. These "special" ballots end up in a "special" place . . . the trash can!

We still strongly believe in our form of picking awards, so we will stick with our system.
