Tournament Rules

- 1) Bowlers are eligible to participate in this tournament if they have paid their 2020-21 USBC Membership dues thru the Greater Baltimore USBC Association (either full membership at \$23 or co-association at \$10).
- 2) **AVERAGE:** Entrants shall use their highest GBUSBCA 21-game average for the 2019-2020 season, whether from winter or summer. If no GBUSBCA yearbook average for the 2019-2020 season, entrant shall use their highest GBUSBCA current average for at least 21 games as of January 1, 2021. If the entrant also has a non-GBUSBCA average listed on bowl.com, their highest bowl.com 21-game average for 2019-2020 will be used for their entering average. Anyone without a valid GBUSBCA average shall use an average of 230. If using the current season's average then a written verification of this average, signed by the secretary, must be provided to the tournament director prior to the start of bowling.
- 3) Prize fund shall be returned 100%. Prize ratio shall be at least 1 in 10 for each event.
- 4) Unlimited multiple participation is permitted. USBC Rule 315 applies.
- 5) Applicable COVID-19 face mask rules are considered a dress code requirement and will be enforced.
- 6) If a bowler has entered an event by the closing date for entries, they can enter that event again based on lane availability.
- 7) USBC Rule 319a(2), ten pin up rule, will not apply.
- 8) USBC Rule 319d applies. Entrant must report (in writing) all prizes which they have qualified for within the last 12 months to tournament management prior to bowling. Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.
- 9) USBC Rule 319c (Rerating) applies. It shall be each entrant's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the entrant, team captain or others. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than actual average. If you have been re-rated in the past 12 months, in any tournament, you must report in writing to the tournament director prior to squad time, if not reported, it is cause for disqualification.
- 10) Bowler shall check in 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Please do not enter the facility early for the later squad so we can safely meet capacity limits at all times.
- 11) Additional squads may be added if COVID-19 concerns require it after the entry deadline.
- 12) A \$25.00 fee will be charged for any checks returned by our bank for non-payment.
- 13) USBC rules applicable to sanctioned tournaments apply when not specifically covered by these rules.
- 14) The Tournament Director shall decide any questions not specifically covered by these rules.
