*<sup>35</sup>Then they brought it to Jesus; and after throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. <sup>36</sup>As he rode along, people kept spreading their cloaks on the road. <sup>37</sup>As he was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power that they had seen, <sup>38</sup>saying,*

On April 10<sup>th</sup> the church will celebrate Palm Sunday. While some congregations combine Palm Sunday and the Passion Story, we will not. We will only celebrate the goodness of Palm Sunday. We will have shouts of, "Blessed in the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" On Palm Sunday evening worship, we continue the celebration and quickly move toward Maundy Thursday. A seder meal in the fellowship will begin Maundy Thursday worship and then conclude in the sanctuary. Maundy Thursday service concludes with the stripping of the altar. We leave the service in silence. Good Friday service continues Maundy Thursday's silence with the remembrance of Jesus' life and death. Good Friday service will be quiet, dark, reflective, and will conclude with the closing of the curtain. Easter Sunday service will begin with the opening of the closed curtain, as we are reminded that Joseph of Arimathea asked Pilate for Jesus' body. Joseph placed Jesus' body in a tomb and sealed the tomb. Guards kept watch because the authorities were afraid Jesus' disciples would come and take his body. The disciples did not need to come and take! God took care of "the rest of the story." **GOD RAISED JESUS FROM THE DEAD!**

You are invited to come and journey. Follow along behind Jesus as He continues his path to the ultimate act of love.



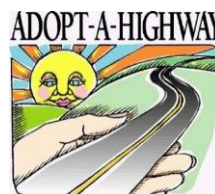
### Food Pantry

- You may have noticed it is brighter in the church. The LED lights have been installed in the sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. With this new lighting Mt. Hermon was able to receive a rebate of \$1,316.00 from Dominion Energy.
- Smoke Detector has been added in the Fellowship Hall.
- Coming soon to Mt. Hermon, two of our youths are working on their Eagle Scout projects, council has approved Tanner Addy's project. Joshua Koon is working on a proposal to bring before the council for his Eagle Scout project.



**Finance Committee** – Due to the Covid 19 issues audits were not performed for the years of 2019 – 2021. The Finance Committee met on March 15, 2022. Audits were performed for Treasurer, LMM, LCY, WELCA and Young at Heart to cover these years. Currently all accounts are up to date and records are sufficient and appropriate. Additional information on WELCA – Due to the WELCA group at Mt. Hermon being disbanded in 2020 the account was closed with a balance of \$1,302.79. This amount was deposited in Mt. Hermon account to “Fund for Funeral Meals”. This was approved by council January 10, 2021.
