BYLAW 1:2013

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184; and
  - b) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184.
2. Council hereby appoints Cheryl Exner as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence January 11, 2013 and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 30 days written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
  - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
  - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
  - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 11, 2013.
