DESCRIPTION: The York Thunderbolt had a well-deserved reputation as one of the better shorter hunting bows. It was priced higher than the Bear Grizzly, and a bit lower than the Browning Safari. Comfortable wide saddle grip. American Walnut riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Four-layer overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. Factory installed quiver/stabilizer bushings. There is a single stress line above and below each bushing insert on the back limb, which was a fairly common development. The stress lines run the full length of the riser but do not extend into the working area of the limb. No crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair shape. This bow was recently shot tested and put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a rug rest and side plate as shown, and a new string.
