A Message From Your Pastor June 2019

On Sunday June 2nd, we will have a special worship service. First, we will celebrate and honor our 2019 Harnett Central High School graduate McKinley Heston. She is a remarkable young lady, from a fine family, and we are so proud of her.

Second, we will hear a presentation from our construction committee about the facilities expansion project. Since early 2019, this committee has been working diligently with architect Tony Johnson to explore the feasibility of a freestanding engineered building on our church campus. Our goal on June 2nd is to consolidate all of this information into a presentation that will be thoroughly informative, but not overwhelming. We are very excited about the prospects of this opportunity and hope that you will share in our excitement on June 2nd during the morning worship service. You will be presented on June 2nd with a design concept for the building and an estimated cost. Following the presentation, there will be time for you to ask questions on Wednesday, June 5th at 7:00pm. Two weeks later, on Sunday June 16th, the congregation will be asked to vote to either approve the construction committee moving forward or not. This vote on June 16th is not a final approval, but an intermediate step of approval which, if passed by the congregation, would allow the construction committee to proceed in getting construction documents, a finalized detailed budget for the project, and a financial package to present to the church. All of that information would come back to the congregation for final approval at future date. Throughout this process the construction committee has been guided by three important commitments:

Ministry Focused – Neill's Creek Baptist is God's Church, not ours, and we desire to glorify him and fulfill God's mission through our church facilities. We believe that a new building on our church campus will greatly enhance our current ministries and open the door for new opportunity to reach our community for Christ.

Growth Oriented – Anticipating the tremendous growth that is already happening in northern/central Harnett County, we desire for this project to position our church with more space and adequate facilities for growth in our congregation over the next 5-10 years.

Financially Responsible & Transparent – We seek to be wise stewards of what God, and the congregation of NCBC, has entrusted to us.

As we prepare for this important discussion as a church family, I ask that you please continue to pray for:

- *Godly wisdom and discernment for our church leaders and congregation;
- *Endurance for our construction committee who have invested significant time and creative energy;
- *Unity in our congregation that we would act in one accord;
- *Faith to respond obediently, as we sense God calling us to this important and historic task for our church.

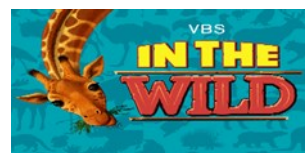
