- We've designed and implemented our program, which focuses on life skills, executive functions, workforce development, and transition planning.
- 85% of our veterans have steady employment or income through our *VHVH Works™* employment partnerships. Participating partners include the Winston-Salem Dash at BB&T Ballpark, Spectra Food Services at Wake Forest University, Rhino Sports and Entertainment Services at Virginia Tech University, and Ezekiel AME Zion Church's Summer Food Program.
- 87% are enrolled in education or job skills training partnerships at places like Forsyth Tech Community College and Goodwill Industries of North West North Carolina.
- And 80% of our graduates are moving into permanent housing.

I tell our growing community of supporters that we have one of the best alumni networks in Winston-Salem, North Carolina of veterans eager to serve and contribute to our local community. I continue to share these stories with our partners and future supporters about the great work that is being done at VHVH.
