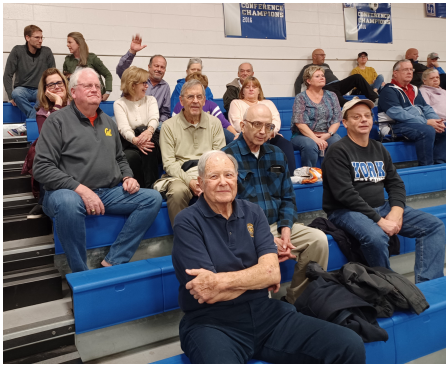


Yorktown Rotary Club
