

Materials List

18" Square Radiance or other solid background

20" square batting and 20" square backing fabric (loose weave is best – no batiks)

Assorted Cotton Fabrics:

- A. - 6" for square inner lotus tip
- B. - 5"x10" for overlay crochet leaf
- C. - 12"x16" for base crochet leaf and lotus petals and corners
- D. - 6"x9" for outer lotus petals
- E. - 6"x10" for reverse applique insert and ruffles of inner star petals
- F. - 5"x7" for star point inserts
- G. - 5"x18" for reverse applique corners and fabric origami insert
- H. - 8" square for inner star applique
- I. - 8" square for fabric origami insert centers

4mm Silk Embroidery Ribbon:

- A. - 2 yards for center star and start points
- B. - 5 yards floral buds, inner star points and corners

Beads (includes a few extras):

- A. - light bugles - 20
- B. - dark bugles - 20
- C. - flat beads - 10
- D. - size 8 for around leaves and misc - 175
- E. - size 8 for lotus outline and misc - 100
- F. - size 8 for inner start points and center - 10
- G. - size 8 for outer Oya fan - 400
- H. - size 8 for stem Oya - 240
- I. - size 8 for knit leaf embroidery - 80

Rick Rack - 1/4" - 1 yard

Yarn:

- A. - cotton sock - for crochet leaves - 20 yards
- B. - wool sock - for knit leaves - 40 yards
- C. - perle 5 cotton DMS for angel wings - 15 yards

Embroidery Threads:

- A. - size 5 Perle - center embroidery and misc - 3 yards
- B. - size 5 Perle - for oya and misc - 40 yards
- C. - size 5 Perle - for blanket stitch and wrap - 5 yards
- D. - size 5 Perle sparkly - 10 yards
- E. - 6 strand embroidery floss light - 3 yards
- F. - 6 strand embroidery floss dark - 3 yards
- G. - size 8 Perle for misc embroidery and blanket around outer points - 10 yards

Size 30 sewing thread for misc embroidery
Sewing thread in various colors
Beading thread to match background color
Border and coordinating fabrics

Supplies List

Assorted needles:

Embroidery, Beading, Applique, Stitching

Crochet hooks:

US size C, Steel size 6 (1.8mm), Steel size 7 (1.5mm)

Knitting needles:

US size 2

Fusible Web (one sided such as Appliquick)

Turning tools (such as Appliquick) or hera marker and start/iron. See previous Video on applique

Applique glue
