Cara Black is a best-selling mystery writer whose first protagonist Aimee LeDus solves.

Mysteries throughout Paris. Each book takes place in a specific arrondissement... the Marais,

Versailles, Bastille which makes each book a visit to Paris with intrigue. Black is extremely knowledgeable of each area, giving the reader a sense of being there.

On her Vespa Aimee chase miscreants through Paris in her rummage sale Chanel suit and garbage can salvaged Manolo Blaniks with the even present tube of Chanel Red lipstick.

Black has written 20 books with Amiee LeDuc.

In her two latest books Cara Black introduces Kate Rees who is a spy sharpshooter from Oregon working with British Secret Service in 1942.

In "Three Hours in Paris", Rees has several missions mostly in Paris and Egypt. One directive is accomplished only to create 3 more and so goes the never-ending terror of a mystery novel and the fast pace of Black's writing.
