


SAINTS

The Catholic Church places great emphasis on moral law and is strong in its devotion to saints. It embraces a mystical dimension - most clearly visible in its liturgy - which sits uneasily with the modern secular and scientific world. At various Marian shrines (Virgin Mary) around the world, for instance, the Catholic Church believes that a small number of miracle cures of illness have been affected.

Great emphasis is placed on the ascetic tradition of religious life as either separation from worldly concerns or, in the words of Pope John Paul II (1978 - 2005) as 'a sign of contradiction in contemporary culture. Catholicism retains from earliest times a strong sense of sin and correspondingly of God's redeeming love.
