In addition to the already proposed changes there was an additional change that will be voted on in OCTOBER which is: Article XV: Use of Revenue

A: All funds and assets of the club shall be used only for the purposes that are consistent with the purpose of the club and for actual administrative expenses in conducting the affairs of the club under the direction and with the approval of the Board of Directors. All expenditures of more than \$2,000.00 for club improvements must be discussed at a regular membership meeting. Must be accompanied with a minimum of 2 bids, and upon acceptance, published in the bulletin and voted on at the next regular or special meeting, where a majority of all members present is required for acceptance.

Proposed change/add: "in the case that two bids are not received in a timely fashion one bid may be accepted."
