Hospice Maui was provided a unique site by the State of Hawaii that overlooks the ocean in one direction, the town of Maui in another direction, and the mountains in another. Unfortunately the site was only one acre in size and sat on the edge of an 80' drop-off. HDR sited the building to allow patients to take advantage of the spectacular views, while recessing the support functions and offices into a day basement with easy access to service and parking. The design of the building recognized local Hawaiian culture in the placement of the beds and aesthetic appeal of the building itself. Extensive use of water was used to create a unique Memorial Garden for those rooms that did not overlook the ocean, a barrier to protect those patient rooms that are actually accessed from an open walkway. The "bridge" over from the parking lot to the building is symbolic of the "crossing over" that is taking place on this ground and the building's separation from its current surroundings.
