To All Association Managers:

The enclosed forms are to be used when making nominations for the Michigan State USBC Hall of Fame in any one of the following categories: "Superior Performance" (white), "Star of Yesteryear" (pink) or "Meritorious Service" (blue).

Anyone may submit names for consideration in these categories by completing the forms and mailing them to the Hall of Fame Committee - c/o 9709 Mueller - Taylor MI 48180, by the deadline of **OCTOBER 18, 2017**.

Important: To have previously submitted Nominations be considered - updated applications are a MUST!

Upon verification of each candidate's qualifications, the Michigan State USBC WBA Hall of Fame committee will select the recipient(s) at a committee meeting.

The basic qualifications for each of the categories are as follows:

SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE:

The nominee must have been a Michigan State USBC /WIBC Women's Bowling Association member for at least ten years and must have shown an outstanding bowling performance. She must have won State recognition for her ability in bowling, and must have also won at least one Michigan State USBC/WIBC Women's Bowling Association Championship Tournament Title as a member of the Actual Team, Doubles, Singles or All Events. Championships earned previously under the Michigan Queens, Michigan Senior Queens, and/or AJBC, YABA or Michigan State USBC Youth may also be considered. Only games and averages bowled in Michigan State USBC Women's Bowling Association certified leagues or tournaments will be considered.

STAR OF YESTERYEAR:

The nominee must have achieved statewide recognition for her bowling ability and must have won at least one Michigan State USBC /WIBC Women's Bowling Association Championship Tournament Title as a member of the Actual Team, Doubles, Singles or All Events. She must have bowled in at least ten (10) Michigan State USBC/WIBC Women's Bowling Association Tournaments, unless illness or injury has shortened her bowling career. Championships earned previously under the Michigan Queens, Michigan Senior Queens, and/or AJBC, YABA or Michigan State USBC Youth may also be considered. Only games and averages bowled in Michigan State USBC Women's Bowling Association certified leagues or tournaments will be considered. She must be at least fifty (50) years of age.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE:

The nominee must have contributed meritorious service a minimum of 15 years to the reputation and progress of the game within the area served by the Michigan State USBC Women's Bowling Association. She must be at least fifty (50) years of age.

A bowler may be elected only once to the Hall of Fame regardless of category. A posthumous award may be presented in any category. Recipients are not necessarily selected in each category every year.
