

## Town of Schodack Schools Before Centralization

<u>District Number</u>	<u>Name</u>	<u>Comments</u>
1	Schodack Landing	Schodack Landing; started in 1857; present building was built in 1905 and was open at centralization in 1951; now the firehouse of the Schodack Landing Volunteer Fire Company.
2	East Schodack	On County Route 7 in East Schodack, north of St. Stephen's Church; built in 1905; second school on this site; still standing.
3	South Schodack; Clove Road School; Brick Schoolhouse	Corner of South Schodack and Clove Roads; built in 1870; still standing but vacant.
4		Became District 14 in Columbia County.
5	Bunker Hill	On north side of School House Road one-quarter of a mile from Route 20; built in 1888 by Frederick Frickinger who donated the school to the town; he was the first in the area to manufacture piano actions; now a private residence.
6	Nickelodeon; Brockway	Across Route 20 from Schodack Police Station; Brockway was second school on site built in 1933; burned by fire company in 1994.
7	Muitzskill	Northeast corner of Schodack Landing Road and Sultan Lane; closed in mid-1940s; burned in 1960s.
8	Shivers Corners; Clapp	Northeast corner of Route 150 and Sagendorf Road; now a private residence.

9		Became District 16 in Columbia County in 1867.
10	Castleton	Northeast corner of Main and Stimpson Streets in Castleton; original wooden school was built in 1820; brick building built in 1838; present building built in 1866 with a later addition; now Castleton Village Hall and library.
11	Stony Point; Prospect Hill	North side of Stony Point Road, east of Route 9J; closed by the time of centralization in 1951; now a private residence.
12	Brookview	East side of Route 150, less than one-quarter mile from Schodack Valley Road; original school was built in 1814 just north of present site on the other side of the road; present building built in 1912 and was still open at 1951 centralization and later used by BOCES; now apartments.
13	Miller Road	On old Miller Road near intersection with Waters Road; now a private residence.
14	Yellow	Northeast corner of Route 9 and Graw Road; sold in 1931 due to lack of students; demolished.
15	White; Maple Hill	Northwest corner of Maple Hill Road and Old Post Road South; school operating at this location by 1857; school built in 1863; closed in 1947 and razed after centralization in 1951.
16	Budd	East side of Bunker Hill Road just south of McClellan Road; demolished.
